Aesthetix president and designer Jim White began his pursuit of the ultimate preamplifier design almost 20 years ago, introducing the Jupiter Series of preamps in 1994. The 'lo' phonostage and 'Callisto' linestage soon became industry benchmarks, only outclassed when their 'Signature' versions which followed set an even higher standard.

The Aesthetix lo is an all-valve phonostage suitable for the most demanding cartridges, including low-output moving coils. It has won numerous awards, receiving worldwide acclaim for its superior sound quality. No expense is spared to achieve the highest audio performance possible. The lo Eclipse is the ultimate realisation of the true capabilities of the lo.

The Eclipse casework is beautifully crafted from constrained-layer damped panels machined from aluminum billet, and sits upon four Harmonic Resolutions Systems' Nimbus Couplers specially made for Aesthetix. This design brings new levels of articulation and clarity, as well as providing excellent ventilation, thus improving longevity and reliability.

The bulk of the internal changes revolve around the new StealthCap[™] from Peter Moncrief. Each individual SteathCap is painstakingly handcrafted using expensive exotic materials in order to optimise the radical Stealth Technology[™]. StealthCaps dramatically reduce corrupting signal reflections in the capacitor plate, just as stealth technology in aircraft reduces radar signal reflections.

The lo Eclipse is designed and engineered to deliver the highest attainable sound from a turntable. This is its sole purpose and is immediately apparent upon listening.

Excellent inter-transient silence preserves the inky blackness of the background, out of which a soundstage of stunning transparency, richness and holographic precision reveals a wealth of subtle musical information.

A complete lack of blurring and time smear ensures that all parts of each musical note cohere together and are articulately focused and united at the same moment, leading to stunning dynamic impact, incredible clarity and complete musical coherence.

Other phonostages and preamplifiers tend to add a layer of haze and blurring to the sound, the absence of which is immediately apparent on listening to the lo Eclipse.
